OFFICE HOURS

Office for entries will be open on Gymkhana day from 6.30am and will close at 4.00pm.

TICKETS

Gate entry will be a gold coin donation with thanks to all our incredible sponsors.

All competitors are to enter via the office on the day – please see schedule for entry details.

DOGS

Dogs are welcome onto the showground but must be kept on a lead at all times unless competing in the Dog High Jump Competition. Dogs are not permitted inside any building, except for registered service dogs.

STALLIONS

Stallions are permitted to participate on the day; however, they must remain on a lead and be under the control of their owner or designated handler when not tied to the float or held in a stallion yard.

EFTPOS or CASH

Eftpos will be available to purchase items at the Office, Canteen or Bar – no service will be provided to get cash out.

SAFETY

Children under 16 need to be accompanied by an adult.

Photo ID is required to purchase alcohol regardless of your age. It is illegal to provide minors with alcohol and anyone caught doing so may be prosecuted and removed from the grounds.

If a rider is seen to be drinking alcohol whilst competing, they will be disqualified from the competition.

If you have any chronic conditions or illnesses (ie asthma, diabetes, epilepsy) be sure to carry information regarding your condition & emergency contact number on you at all times.

Make sure you dress in accordance with the weather forecast. Wear sensible shoes & clothes and bring a raincoat if needed.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION

Under extreme & unlikely circumstances a building, area or the entire site may be required to be evacuated or cleared. It will be imperative for you to follow all instructions & directions from emergency services, police, fire brigade & / or the volunteers that would be requested of you in such a situation. Remember these people are only there to help, so please pay attention.

FIRST AID

There will be a Paramedic from Get First Aid services located near the horse entry of the oval to treat people who have injured themselves on the day or are ill.

PARKING

Horse competitors, shearing competitors and disabled parking will be available within the showgrounds on the day. Spectators and other competitor's car parking will be available at the Dalton Cemetery which is only a short walking distance from the grounds.

SMOKING

Smoking is ONLY allowed in the designated area, which is in the vicinity of the cricket nets, no smoking allowed in any other area and please be mindful of children.

RUBBISH

Rubbish bins will be available on site, please do the right thing and put it in the bin.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IF IT IS RAINING?

Event organisers will make a call as early as possibly based on the amount of rain leading up to the event and the possibility of rain on the day. Website and facebook event updates will be posted at least 3 days before the event.

CAN I CAMP THE NIGHT BEFORE?

Yes, to horse competitors ONLY! Feel free to arrive Saturday night to set up camp and be ready for the Gymkhana early Sunday morning! Maximum two nights stay. There will be a small communal campfire Saturday night.

Camping is also available at the Gunning Showground which is a 10 min drive from Dalton.

DO I HAVE TO WEAR A HELMET?

YES! All riders must wear helmets whilst on horseback. Helmets can save people lives when horse riding, imagine if you chose not to wear a helmet that one time...

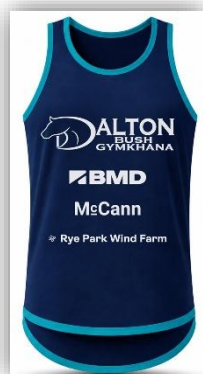

- A team representative will be responsible for organising their team to be at the nominated area at 12.00pm and to make themselves known to Chief Steward.
- Competition will begin at 1.00pm in front of the canteen area.
- The rope we will use will be marked at the centre, 3m and 5m points.
- Each competition is the best of 3 pulls and teams will change ends after each pull.
- A coin toss will determine which team will be invited to select their first end.
- The rope will be placed on the ground with the centre marker on the rope being aligned with a mark in the ground.
- Teams will adopt their starting position by having the team line up to the rope, facing the opposition, with the first member standing at the 5m point from the centre.
- When teams are ready the Chief Steward will give the direction to **Take up the rope**.
- Both teams will pick up the rope and adjust their positions without straining the rope.
- The next command will be **Take the strain**. Teams then strain the rope and maybe required by the Chief Steward to move forward or back to position the centre mark on the rope in line with the ground marker.
- When the rope is in position, and both teams are steady, the command to **Heave** will be given.
- The pull will be decided when one of the 3m markers on the rope crosses the centre line on the ground.
- The Chief Stewards decision, or that of a nominated judge, as to the winner of each contest will be final.

No bitches in oestrus permitted on showgrounds

- By entering, handlers do so at their own risk. Dalton Bush Gymkhana and event organisers will not be held liable for any loss, damage or injury to the handler, dogs or their property and waiver must be signed prior to completing.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead whilst on the grounds unless in competition area

Dog High Jump Competition Rules

- The competition is a test of the dog's jumping ability
- Small breeds open to dogs 35cm and under (dogs will be measured by officials, their decision is final)
- The dog is permitted to jump on to or over the jump
- All dogs not competing must be on a lead with a handler in the marshalling area behind the competition area
- Only ONE (1) dog may be loose in the competition area at any one time
- Every dog must compete at every height
- There must be a handler at the top of the jump to act as a catcher if necessary, and a handler as a catcher at the bottom
- Each dog is allowed three (3) attempts at each height if necessary
- In the event of two (2) dogs jumping the same height, the winner shall be determined as the dog that had the least number of refusals
- A dog may compete on a loose lead or must be released at a minimum of three (3) metres from the jump
- ANY MISHANDLING OR MISTREATMENT OF A DOG WILL INCUR IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION
- If, in the opinion of the Steward, a dog is unsafe to other competitors or the general public, it will be withdrawn from the competition

Starting time - 8.30am

Entries for Sporting will ONLY be available on the day from the office between 6.30am and closing at **8.00am** – ***Eftpos or Cash will be available for Entry fees.***

All Competitors compete at their own risk and Waiver Forms **MUST BE COMPLETED & SIGNED** prior to entries being taken. For quicker registration, all waiver forms will be available on the Gunning Show website, under Dalton Bush Gymkhana tab.

All Competitors MUST wear appropriate head gear and attire whilst mounted on a horse and/or competing.

No Horse Yards or Stalls are available at the grounds.

Camping is ONLY available to Horse competitors the night before event. Camping is also available at the Gunning Showground which is only a 10 minute drive from the grounds.

NO ALCOHOL TO BE TAKEN INTO THE ARENA – NO WARNINGS, IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION

Rules and Regulations of Horse Sporting

Flag Race

- 5th flag to be taken first, then 4th, 3rd, 2nd and flag nearest drum last.
- Should the competitor fail to lodge any flags in the drum, he must dismount, pick up flag, mount, replace flag in cask and finish.
- If drum is knocked over, it must be stood up immediately before continuing for next flag.
- Each competitor must keep in to his or her own line of pegs, and each competitor must keep within these lines. Crossing these lines will mean disqualification.
- Should a competitor while crossing these lines in doing so, interfere in any way with another line of pegs, another competitor or his or her horse, the heat, the semi-final or final shall be stopped as speedily as possible, re-run, but the competitor causing the infringement will be automatically disqualified.
- The rider of the first horse past the winning post will be declared the winner, only when he or she is mounted on his or her horse, has the five flags in the cask, and has completed the course in accordance with these rules.

Bending Race

- Start on left side of drum and pass on left side of 1st peg then bend all other pegs, giving a right turn at the last peg.
- Finish on the left side of drum coming back.
- Rider disqualified if peg is knocked down or running a wrong course.

Barrel Race

- Either left or right course can be run.
- 5 second penalty for touching a barrel, knocking over a barrel.
- Riders disqualified for running a wrong course.



Keyhole Race

- The rider must have the horse inside the line and the horse must stop his forward motion before starting the race.
- Competitor rides down the lane turning inside the circle and returning down the lane.
- Time starts and stops upon entering and leaving the lane.
- Rider will be disqualified if a horse steps on or over the line.

In & Out of the Paddock

- There will be four jumping rails, four bending poles, jump blocks for poles to rest on.
- The rider enters through the start/finish, over jump and around bending pole on left rein.
- Course is completed on the same rein.
- Elimination is incurred for Error on course, knocking down jump pole and knocking over bending pole.

Western Bending Race

- There will be 5 pegs, and competitor must leave the first peg on the right
- Each competitor must keep to his/her own line of pegs
- Knocking down any of the pegs will mean disqualification
- Pegs should not be touched by the competitors' hands
- A peg or pegs broken will be deemed a knock down peg
- The winner and place getters are declared when the riders have passed the finishing line, mounted on their horses and with all pegs in his/her line standing and the course has been completed in accordance with these rules.

Should any owner have more than one horse in the final, he is to provide another rider!
Prize money and prizes will be collected after each event

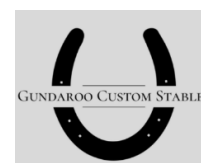

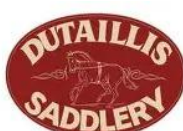

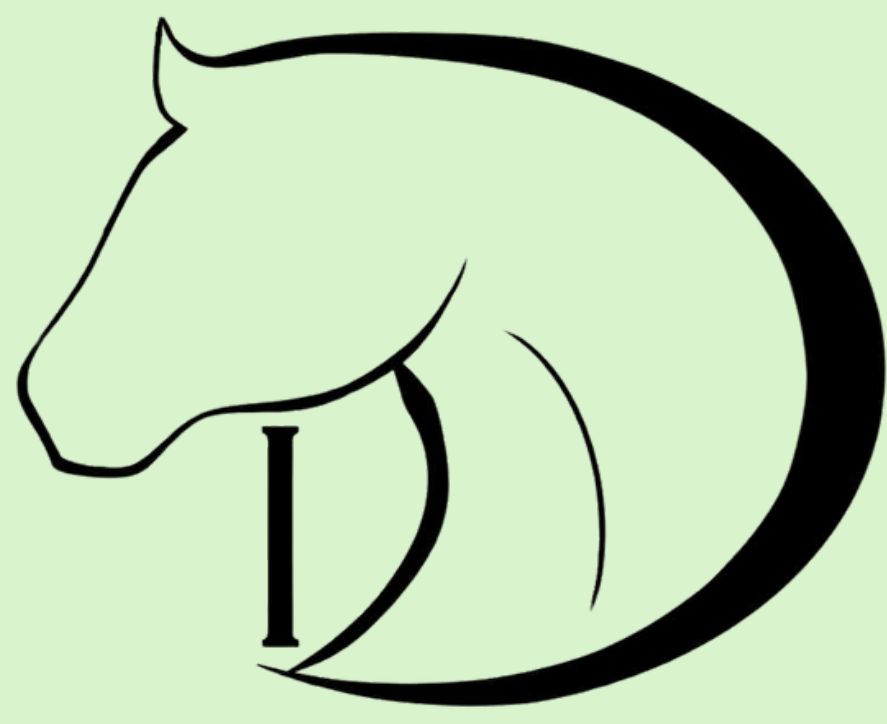
